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KING OF ENGLAND DECLARES WAR ON BFA

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WAREHOUSE MASSACRE: PLEXOCOOP COVER-UP?

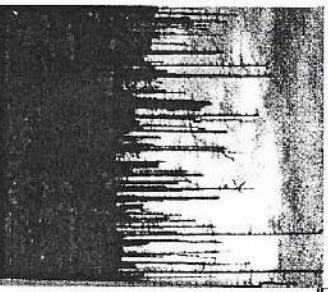

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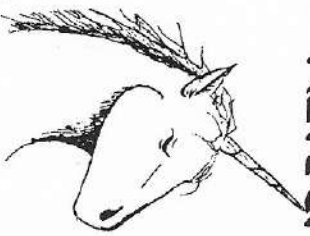
